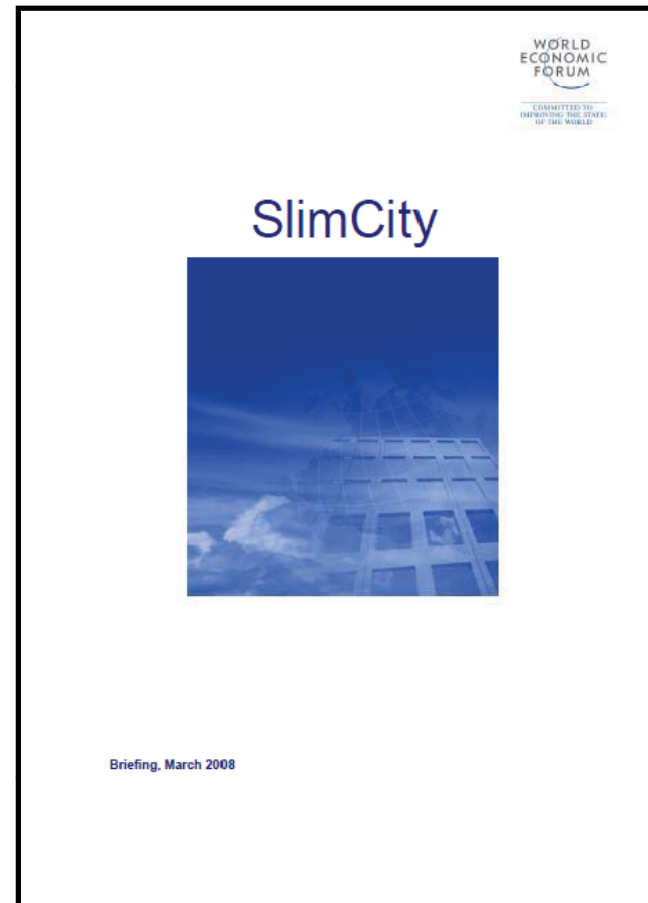

- Other themes addressed include health, climate change, waste, water and planning



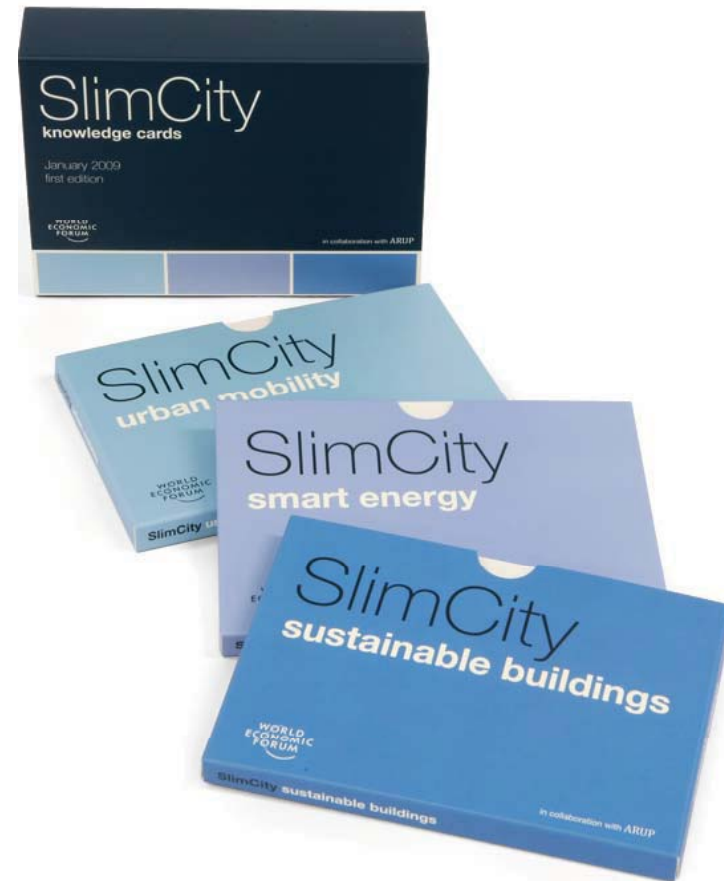
Knowledge Partner to the Forum
